Notes.

1.1 Multiple Category Options. The Agniveer candidates can **SELECT TWO** Agniveer Categories over and above Regular Entry Categories (i.e, those which are for permanent enrolment in Indian Army) based on their eligibility. **The candidates seeking two options will have to fill up forms/ apply for the two categories separately, appear for two Common Entrance Examinations, pertaining to their choice of Categories. However, they will be required to undergo only one Recruitment Rally and Medical Test for the Category meriting higher Physical Fitness Test/Medical standards. Priority of Categories will be filled up by the candidate during application stage itself. Final option will be endorsed by candidate post completion of recruitment rally. However, merit and selection would be carried out based on default priority of various Categories including Regular Entry Categories. Candidates will be permitted to select lower priority Categories after merit list is prepared prior to despatch to Training/ Regimental Centres based on submitting a 'No Claim Certificate' as per format enclosed at Appendix 'A'.**

1.2 Priority for Selection in Trades under AV Tradesman Category. Candidates are required to enter their choice of trades under AV Tradesman Category during Application Stage. A total of **UPTO 07 TRADE OPTIONS** under **AV Tradesman (10th Pass) Category** and **UPTO TWO TRADE OPTIONS** under **AV Tradesman (8th Pass) Category** will be provided to candidates for fixing their PRIORITY for selection. Further, if a Candidate chooses not to enter a particular Trade in choice of Priorities, the candidate may not be considered for selection despite being in merit and will performe forgo selection due to non-availability of vacancies in chosen Categories as per priority. Trade Specific duties of various tradesmen in the Army are as enlisted in **Appendix A-1.**

1.3 Candidates who have appeared in class 10th, class 12th Board Exam, NIOS and ITI course and who are awaiting declaration of results are also eligible to apply provided they fulfill all other Qualification Required. Such candidates, however, shall only be selected when they produce the original mark sheet during the Phase II of recruitment process.

2. **Date of Birth:** Candidates born between **01 Jul 2005 to 01 Jul 2009** (both days inclusive) are eligible to apply under **Agnipath Scheme.**

Notes.

- In case a candidate is found to have made fake claims at any stage or furnished fake certificates to unfairly secure Bonus Marks or relaxation in Physical Measurement Standards (for sports person only), his candidature is liable to be CANCELLED at any stage of recruitment.**
- The above marks are fixed depending upon the eligibility of a candidate and has no relation to his performance in Common Entrance Examination (CEE). **Bonus Marks will be only used to formulate final Merit.**
- Maximum bonus marks that can be given for all Agniveer Categories **except Agniveer (Technical)** is 25 Marks (NCC 'C' Certificate and participated in Republic Day Parade) even if a candidate qualifies for more than one type of bonus marks.
- Maximum bonus marks that can be given to **Agniveer (Technical)** is 50 Marks if he is qualified in ITI/Diploma {Serial 6 (6.8) refers}, **even if the candidate qualifies for more than one type of bonus marks.**
- TWO** wards (including adopted son/daughter) of Service/Ex-Servicemen/War Widow/Widow of Ex-servicemen can avail bonus marks.
- All original certificates and Mark sheets including the **HIGHEST EDUCATION QUALIFICATION** as filled up in the application form online is to be carried by all above categories at rally site.
- Sports Certificates are valid for **TWO YEARS** from the first day of Common Entrance Examination.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

7. Agniveer will be enrolled in the Indian Army under Indian Army Act 1950 for a period of four years. Agniveer would form a distinct rank in the Indian Army, different from any other existing ranks. Indian Army is not obliged to retain Agniveer beyond the engagement period of four years.
8. On completion of four years of service, based on organisation's requirements and policies promulgated by the Indian Army, Agniveer will be offered an opportunity to apply for permanent enrolment in the Indian Army. These applications will be considered in a centralised manner based on objective criteria including performances during their four years engagement period and upto 25% of each specific batch of Agniveer will be enrolled in regular cadre of Indian Army. **Agniveer will not have any right to be selected for further enrolment into the Indian Army. Selection of the Agniveer for further enrolment, if any, shall be at the discretion of the Indian Army.**
9. **Employability.** Agniveer enrolled under this entry are liable to be assigned any duty in organisational interest, at the discretion of the Indian Army.
10. **Training.** On being enrolled, Agniveer will be imparted military training based on requirement of Indian Army.
11. **Leave.** Grant of leave will be subject to exigencies of Indian Army. The following leave may be applicable for Agniveer during their engagement period:-
- 11.1. Annual Leave : 30 days per year.
- 11.2. Sick Leave : Based on medical advice.
12. **Medical and CSD Facilities.** For the duration of their engagement period in Indian Army, Agniveer will be entitled for medical facility at Service Hospitals as well as CSD provisions.
13. **Pay, Allowances and Allied Benefits.** Agniveer enrolled under this scheme will be paid an Agniveer package with a fixed yearly increment. In addition, Risk and Hardship Allowances (as applicable in Indian Army), Dress and Travel Allowances will be paid.
14. **Terminal Benefits - Seva Nidhi Package.** Agniveer will be given onetime 'Seva Nidhi' package comprising their monthly contribution with matching contribution by the Government on completion of their engagement period, as indicated below:-

- Note: 1.** Agniveer will not be required to contribute to any Provident Fund of the Government.
- Note: 2.** There shall be no entitlement to any gratuity and any kind of pensionary benefits in case of Agniveer.

15. **Insurance, Death and Disability Compensation.** Agniveer will be provided non-contributory life insurance cover of Rs 48 lakhs for the duration of their engagement period as Agniveer in the Indian Army. Agniveer will not be governed by provisions contained in the Pension Regulations/Rules for Indian Army.

16. **Agniveer Skill Certificate.** At the end of engagement period, a detailed Skill-Set Certificate will be provided to the Agniveer highlighting the skills and level of competency acquired by the personnel during **their engagement period.**
17. Personnel enrolled under this scheme will not be eligible for Ex-Servicemen Status.
18. Only unmarried candidates will be eligible for enrolment as Agniveers and they must undertake not to marry during the defined engagement period of four years. Agniveers who marry during the said period would be released from service. Further, only unmarried Agniveers will be eligible for re-enrolment in regular cadre as Sepoy/equivalent on selection as currently in vogue.

SEQUENCE OF RECRUITMENT

19. Procedure for Online Registration

- 19.1. Candidates are required to have an active email & mobile number which will be used for further communication.
- 19.2. Candidate should enter AADHAAR number in online application.
- 19.3. All candidates to log in to **www.joinindianarmy.nic.in**, check their eligibility status and create their profile. Candidates should fill in Highest Educational Qualification during Registration and Education Qualification mandated as per category applied for during Application stage.
- 19.4. Online Registration (submission of application) will commence from **13 February 2026 to 01 April 2026** (Dates are subject to change and candidates are advised to follow the same on www.joinindianarmy.nic.in).
- 19.5. Candidates are required to fill in their correct height upto millimeter as per category applied for, region based physical measurement standards, as well as special relaxations in height and weight as laid out in www.joinindianarmy.nic.in. Candidates who fill wrong height and weight or produce bogus / unauthorised certificate for seeking relaxation in physical measurement standards are liable for cancellation of candidature during Phase-II (Recruitment Rally).
- 19.6. **Examination Fee.** Examination fee of Rs 250/- per Category of application is to be paid by the candidate for the online examination. The candidate on successfully filling the application will be directed to HDFC portal through a link on the website. At the HDFC portal, make online payment of Rs 250/- plus Bank charges as applicable.
- 19.7. Candidates must indicate **Five Choices** of the exam center. All possible effort would be made to allot exam center based on choice made by the candidate. Exam center can be allotted outside of the choice made by the candidate due to administrative restrictions. "Any candidate opting for Agniveer Clerk/ Store Keeper Technical as an option/ priority for recruitment will be able to choose only those examinations Centers with the facility for conduct of Typing Test. The list of Centers with Typing Test facility is enclosed as **Appendix 'B'**"
- 19.8. Request for change of exam center or date of selection test will not be entertained.
- 19.9. Duplicate/incomplete/erroneously filled application will be rejected.
- 19.10. Category wise link has been provided on JIA website to enable candidates to practice online Common Entrance Exam as per their category. All candidates are advised to carry out practice at least once before appearing for actual Common Entrance Exam.
- 19.11. Animated videos '**How to Register**' and '**How to Appear for online Common Entrance Exam**' are available on www.joinindianarmy.nic.in (Join Indian Army).

19.12 Candidates are advised to upload only recent photograph on JIA website with **proper haircut and clean shave except Sikh candidates**. In case the photo does not match the face of candidate, the candidate will not be permitted to appear for any test.

19.13 Details about required educational qualification, physical / medical standard are available on www.joinindianarmy.nic.in (Join Indian Army) under Candidates login and it can be accessed without signing in.

20. **Recruitment Process.** Recruitment process will be conducted in two phases. **Phase-I** will be Online Common Entrance Exam at Computer Based Test Centers allotted to the candidate and **Phase-II** will be Recruitment Rally by Army Recruiting Office, Cuttack at Rally Venue.

Phase-I

21. **Online Common Entrance Examination (CEE).**

21.1. Candidates are to report at the Examination Centre with colour print out of Admit Card. Candidates shall be debarred from appearing in online test in case anomalies/irregularities/incorrect information are observed during initial verification at the examination venue or at any subsequent stage of selection process. Download Admit Card from www.joinindianarmy.nic.in (Join Indian Army).

21.2. Candidates not reporting for the test on due date & time will not be accommodated on other dates.

21.3. Entry gates at exam center will be opened one and a half hour prior to scheduled time of exams and will close 30 mins prior to time of exam. No candidate will be allowed to enter once the entrance gate is closed.

21.4. Candidates should carry Aadhar Card (as displayed on the Admit Card) as proof of Identity for both phases of test ie Online CEE, Recruitment Rally and Medical Test.

21.5. No electronic gadgets are permitted at the examination centres. Candidates will undergo following activities at the exam centre:-

21.5.1. Frisking at Entry Gate.

21.5.2. Checking of Admit Card & Aadhaar Card at the checking point (**including Facial/Biometric & AADHAR Authentication**).

21.5.3. Auto allotment of Exam Hall.

21.5.4. Attendance at Exam Hall Gate.

21.5.5. Capture of Biometric (IRIS / retina, Photo & Thumb impression) inside the exam hall.

21.5.6. Login ID to allotted computer terminal.

21.5.7. Appear for test as per procedure.

21.5.8. Exit Biometric before exiting the Examination Hall.

21.6. Common Entrance Examination (CEE) will be conducted in 13 languages (ie English, Hindi, Malayalam, Kannada, Tamil, Telugu, Punjabi, Odiya, Bengali, Urdu, Gujarati, Marathi and Assamese).

21.7. Online test will be objective **Multiple Choice Question (MCQ)**. As per category of application the candidates would be required to answer 50 questions in one hour or 100 questions in two hours.

21.8. Marking pattern for online test:-

21.8.1. Full marks for every correct answer.

21.8.2. Nil marks for unattempted question.

21.8.3. All questions, if attempted, will be considered for evaluation, even if marked for review.

21.9. **Typing Test for Agniveer Clerk /Store Keeper Technical.** Typing test for candidates appearing for Agniveer Clerk/Store Keeper Technical will be carried out during the online Common Entrance Exam wherein 30 words per min (wpm) in English during the test is desirable. Only those candidates who qualify the typing test will be eligible for call up for Phase-II of recruitment process.

21.10. Marks scored by the candidates in Online Common Entrance Exam will be Normalised to take into account variation in difficulty levels of the question paper across different sessions.

21.11. In case any candidate is found using unfair means, the candidate will not be allowed to complete the test and candidature will be cancelled.

Phase-II

22. Proportionate to the vacancies available candidates would be shortlisted by applying a cut off in written exam result. The Roll No of the candidates who are in merit will be published on Join Indian Army website. These candidates will receive a **second Admit Card** for balance of recruitment process as per Rally Schedule of Army Recruiting Office, Cuttack. The Admit Card for Phase-II of recruitment process can also be downloaded online under candidate's login (profile) on Join Indian Army web portal <https://joinindianarmy.nic.in>. (The sequence of Phase-II of Recruitment Rally is as per the URL www.joinindianarmy.nic.in/recruitment).

23. Shortlisted candidates have to report on the stipulated date and time for phase-II at the designated Recruitment Rally venue with following document /certificate in original alongwith two attested photocopies with them. **NO CERTIFICATE** to claim Bonus Marks / Relaxation, to include NCC Certificates, Sports Certificate, Relationship Certificate or any other certificate would be accepted after termination of the Rally as the same are required to be verified from issuing authorities in time for final merit preparation :-




